The event was organized by the "Be Human (*Kun Insan*) for Development and Social Care" Foundation on Thursday, March 31, 2022, at the Princess Khadija Palace in Helwan, with the attendance of numerous executive and community leaders.



Awareness Seminar: "Together We Can Eradicate Illiteracy"

The Faculty of Arts at Helwan University held an awareness seminar titled "Together We Can Eradicate Illiteracy" to educate male and female students about the national project for literacy. The event was held under the patronage of Prof. Dr. Mamdouh Mahmoud Mahdi, Acting President of Helwan University, and Prof. Dr. Maha Hosny, Dean of the Faculty of Arts, with the supervision of Prof. Dr. Amany El-Sayed, Vice Dean for Community Service and Environmental Development. It featured the participation of Prof. Dr. Ahmed Abdel Rasheed Hussein, General Coordinator and Supervisor of the National Literacy Project at the university and former Vice Dean of the Faculty of Education for Community Service and Environmental Development, and was organized by Dr. Amal Maatouk, Coordinator of the Literacy Project at the Faculty of Arts.

The seminar covered the following topics:

- The problem of illiteracy in Egypt: Its causes and consequences for individuals and society.
- An introduction to the National Literacy Project, affiliated with the esteemed Supreme Council of Universities.
- Mechanisms and steps for Helwan University students to join the National Literacy Project, according to the protocol signed with the General Authority for Adult Education.
- Benefits of student participation in the National Literacy Project.
- An overview of the content of the reading, writing, and arithmetic curriculum approved by the General Authority for Adult Education for teaching in literacy classes.
- Defining the roles of teachers and learners in literacy classes.
- The experience and achievements of Helwan University in the National Literacy Project in collaboration with the General Authority for Adult Education.

The seminar was attended by more than 240 male and female students from various departments and divisions/majors of the Faculty of Arts, who showed great enthusiasm and interaction to join the National Literacy Project and contribute with their peers from other university faculties in the national epic to eradicate illiteracy in our dear country, Egypt.

Lecture: "Climate Change and the Role of Youth in Adapting to It"



Initiative for a Sustainable Environment – Approval by the Faculty of Arts Council, No. (321) on 7/25/2022

In line with the state's directives to host the COP 27 Conference of the Parties in Sharm El-Sheikh from November 7-18, 2022, the Faculty of Arts launched the "Towards a Sustainable Environment" initiative. The initiative targets university students to raise awareness of environmental risks that, in turn, affect the climate and lead to long-term climate change.

The environment, in the last century, has been affected by greenhouse gas emissions resulting from the industrial revolution, which has led to global warming, as well as the accumulation of waste and the failure to sort it, leading to the emission of methane gas, one of the most significant greenhouse gases. Global warming, in turn, affects the soil, water, and biodiversity sectors.

The initiative aims to enhance the role of youth in participating in environmental and climate action to achieve a sustainable and livable environment for current and future generations, in light of the challenges facing the world, especially the current generation, from the repercussions of climate change resulting from environmental imbalance.

All youth, regardless of their specializations, are responsible for preserving the environment and thus confronting the phenomenon of climate change through a program or initiative aimed at educating youth about the issue of climate change, its resulting dangers, and how to face them.

The initiative then aims to train the faculty's youth to participate in serving the surrounding environment, which is one of the objectives of the Vice Deanship for Community Service and Environmental Development, by launching the following activities within the initiative:

1. "Plant a Tree" Campaign: Urging students to plant trees in various locations around the faculty in cooperation with relevant authorities or through self-help efforts.
2. "Use Organic Products" Campaign: As they do not consume energy and therefore do not cause carbon emissions.

3. "Rationalize Energy and Water Consumption" Campaign: To address the scarcity of water supplies in the coming years, as well as to limit the production of new electricity that results in new amounts of carbon emissions.
4. Launch of Training Programs: To raise awareness about the concept of climate change, its resulting risks, how to confront and adapt to them, and its relationship with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals and Egypt's Vision 2030.

The competition was launched in cooperation between the Vice Deanship for Community Service and Environmental Development and the Youth Welfare Department at the Faculty on 25/7/2022, and the submission period was extended until 10/9/2022.
