

Ekram Fahmy Hussein is an Associate Professor in the Department of Philosophy, with a specialization in Logic and the Philosophy of Science. Was born in 1961 and has built a distinguished academic career in the field of philosophy. Dr. Ekram graduated from the Faculty of Arts, Cairo University, Department of Philosophy in 1985.
